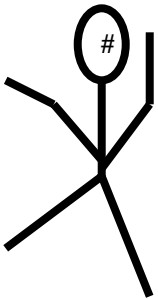


The Effects of MEDICAL Problems and Aging on MEMORY LOSS

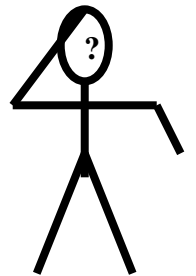
- ◆ What are medical causes of memory problems
